

WILLIAMS: Football aside from music


SOTONYE: I love playing football and video games.

Recognizing the difference between Love and the intoxicating feeling of Infatuation is vital if you desire to have a successful relationship. 1. Financial Direction:

Having a budget can help you have financial direction. With this your spending becomes more purposeful and guided. For example, to buy a house in two years, you have to develop suitable financial strategies and follow specific guidelines. 2. Financial Control:
